San Francisco

Our plantation home is a galleried house in the old Creole style, replete with fine period antiques and furnishings, revealing the most glorious nature of "La Belle Epoque" — a time when only the finest living and accoutrements would do! The exterior portrays the house in all its splendor with its advanced 19th century architecture, Gothic windows, ornate embellishments and gingerbread trim. The enormous ventilated roof is one of the most unusual and interesting characteristics, in addition to the prominent, "bookend" cisterns — the home's water supply — where water was stored and routed into the house.

Come and visit this exceptional example of southern grandeur and exquisite architectural design, on the banks of the mighty Mississippi River, just forty minutes away from downtown New Orleans.

Built in 1856, the house was originally named *Sans Fracoin*, a name derived from a French slang phrase meaning, "without a penny in my pocket" in reference to its high construction costs.

Influenced by Louise's Bavarian heritage, the Plantation boasts a vivid palette, hand-painted ceilings, faux marble and faux bois, and period antiques. In the '70s, an authentic restoration costing several million dollars restored the house to all its antebellum glory.

Guides in period dress will stir your imagination with stories and anecdotes as you visit the main house, original school house and slave quarters.
